RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ✓ **Players are restricted to playing for 1 team at each grade level only, regardless of division (e.g., a 4th grade boy can't play on a 4th grade boy's NBA team and a 4th grade boy's NCAA team).**
- ✓ 4 quarters, 6 minutes each (clock stops on all whistles) – 3 timeouts per game.
- ✓ Bonus shot on 10th team foul in a Half (one and one only – no super bonus).
- ✓ 3rd, 4th & 5th grade cannot press until the last 2 minutes of the game. If a team is winning by 6 points or more, they cannot press.

- ✓ 3rd boys & 4th grade girls leagues, once a team gains control in their backcourt, defenses must retreat at least to their opponents 3 point line until the ball crosses half court, at which time they may come out & play defense. Too often, stronger teams wait at the half court line and steal the ball from inexperienced teams as soon as they cross that line. We'll try this for a team's 1st 3 games and then revisit it, if changes are warranted.
- ✓ 6th, 7th, 8th grade may press anytime until up by 10 points.
- ✓ 3rd & 4th grade free throw distance is 11 feet, 5th grade is 13 feet, 6th grade 15 feet.
- ✓ 28.5 ball used / 10' baskets / court size: 75' X 43'. 6th, 7th, 8th grade leagues use 29.5 ball
- ✓ 6 personal fouls to foul out of game in grades 3 through 5 / all other grades, it is 5 fouls.
- ✓ Technical foul (unsportsmanlike conduct/zero tolerance policy) = 2 points and the ball.
- ✓ Overtime – a 2:00 minute Sudden Death period, first point wins or if no one scores in 2:00 period, a tie will be declared (**except in playoffs - full 2 minute OT period till winner decided*).
- ✓ Teams are responsible for supplying their own, numbered jerseys.
- ✓ **2 IHSA registered officials used per game.**
- ✓ Awards are issued for 1st thru 4th (10 trophies max per team).
